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Preface

The second page includes charts covering the past five fiscal years (FY 2007-2011) for each of FRA's six safety performance measures/goals mandated under the Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA).

The safety-related data for FY 2011 are preliminary and subject to change in the coming months. The safety performance charts will be updated and distributed every quarter (three months).

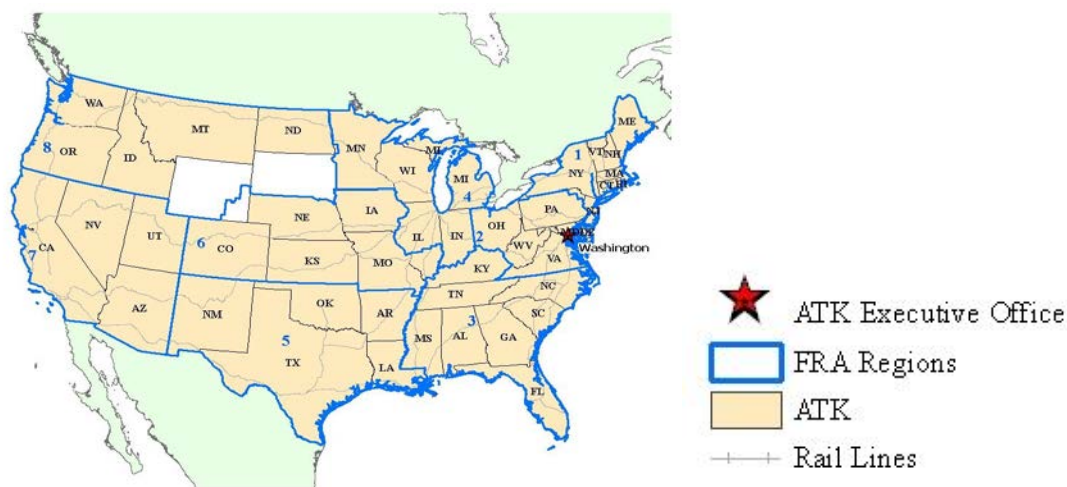

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Amtrak (ATK) Safety Performance (FY 2007-2011)



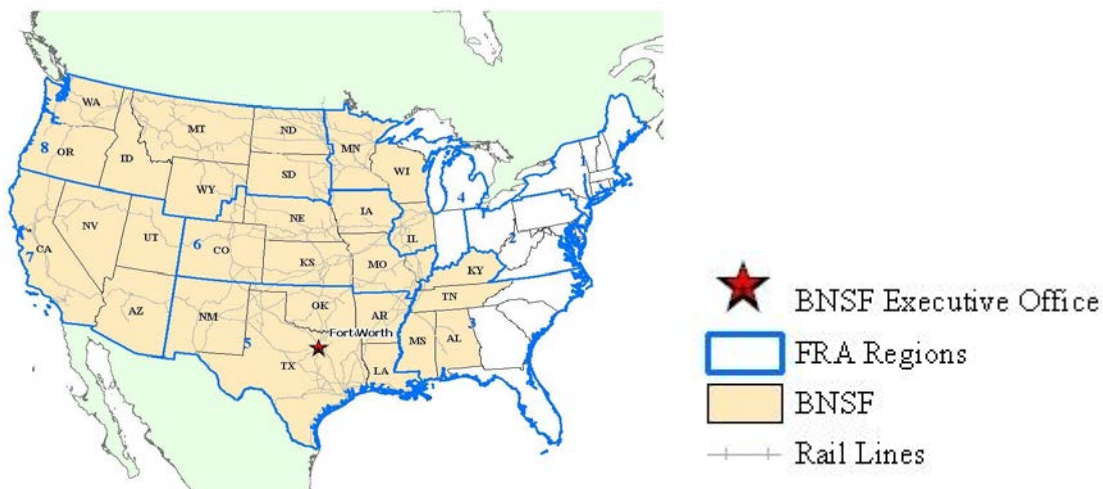

Canadian National - North America (CN) Safety Performance (FY 2007-2011)



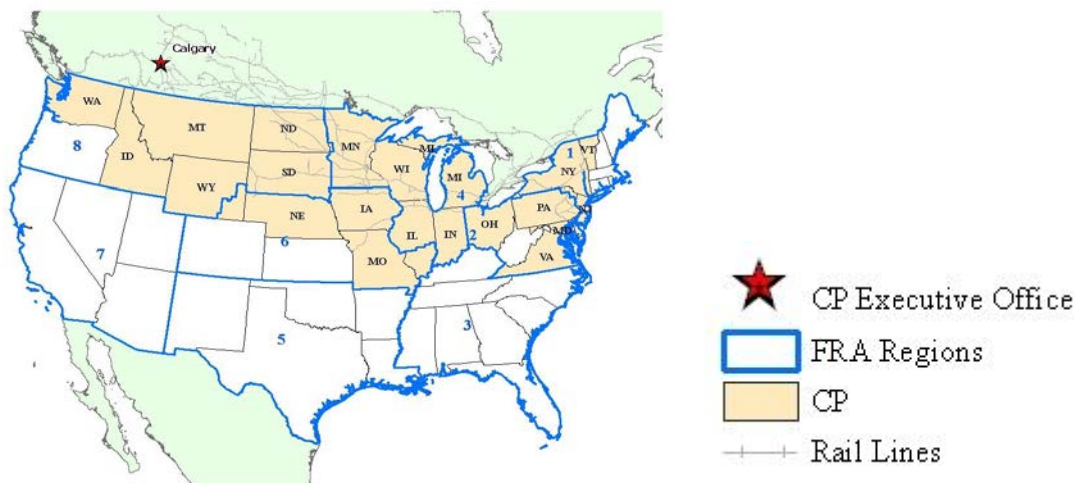

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Canadian Pacific Railway (CP) Safety Performance (FY 2007-2011)



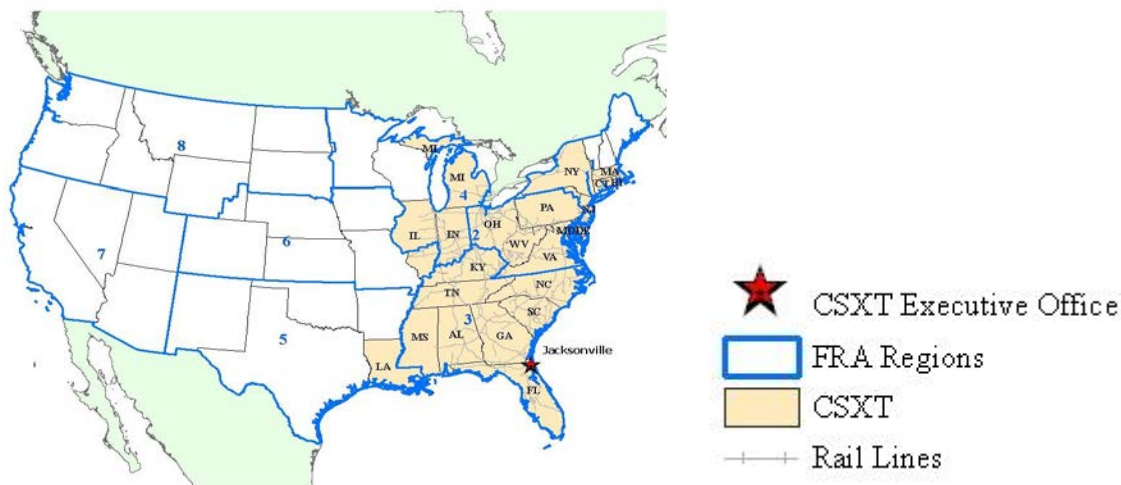

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CSX Transportation Inc. (CSXT) Safety Performance (FY 2007-2011)



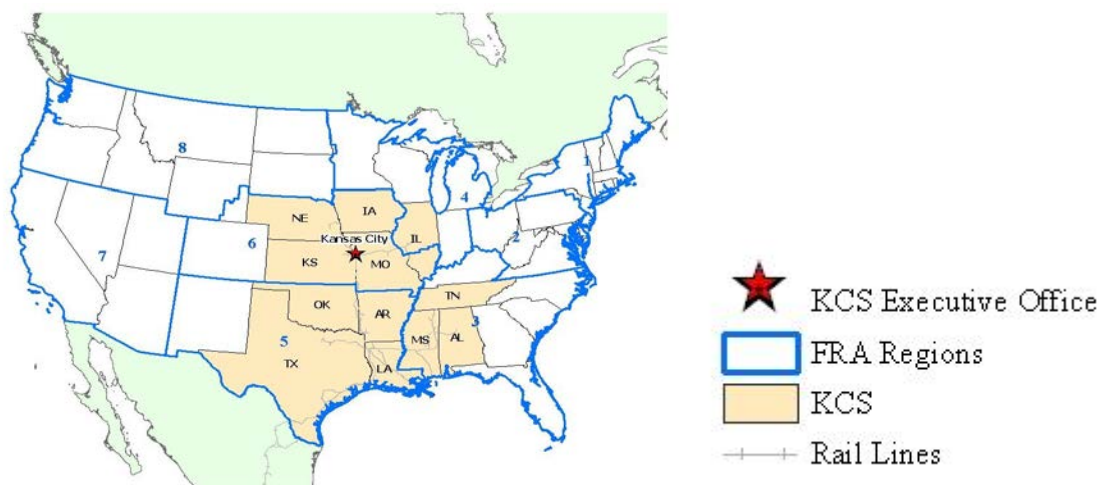

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Kansas City Southern Railway (KCS) Safety Performance (FY 2007-2011)



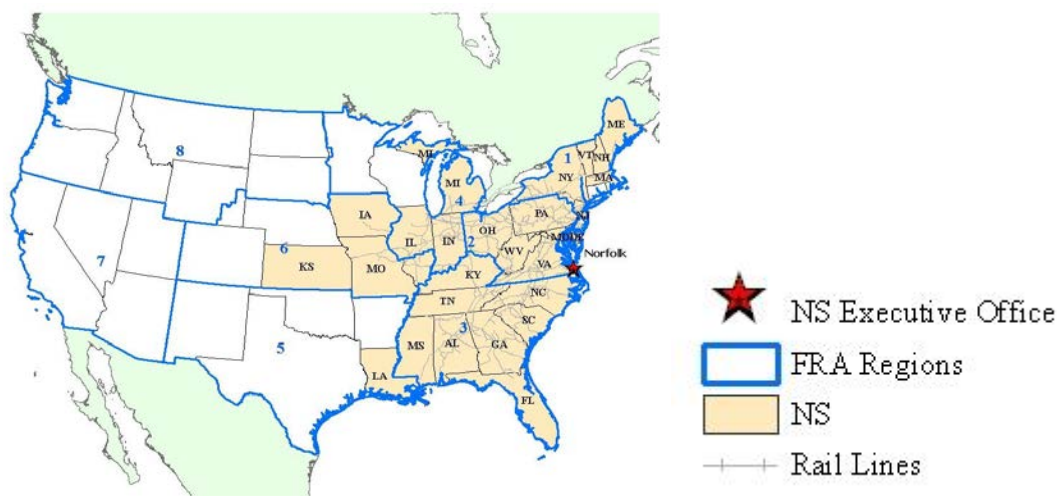
